11421 Nancy B. Purdy was born in the Village of Ovid, N. Y. April 15 1832 and died in the same place Nov. 6 1872. She was married Nov 18 1856 to Joseph Hause, a son of Joseph Hause and Eunice Rogers Hause, who was born March 24 1821 and died May 18 1864. Joseph Hause was born at Tyrone, N. Y. and was a descendant of John Hause who was born in Germany about 1690. He came to Seneca County about 1850 and engaged in teaching school in which he was successful for a number of years in the towns of Covert and Ovid, and which avocation he followed for a number of years until failing health obliged him to discontinue this calling. At the time of his death he was engaged in the Fire insurance business. Their children were.

114212 Thomas Purdy Hause was born in the village of Ovid, N. Y. on Feb 29 1860 and although he claims to be forty four years old, has had but nine anniversaries of his birth. He was married April 2 1881 to Jessie Elizabeth Prantz, a daughter of Daniel F. and Margaret Elaine Prantz of Ovid, N. Y. who was born Jan. 26 1863.

At an early age he entered the office of the Ovid Independent and there learned the printer's trade. After remaining with that paper for a number of year, he removed to the Village of Farmer, now called Interlaken, and there began the publication of a weekly paper under the name of the Saturday Review. He afterwards changed the name of the paper to the Farmer Review, and more recently when the name of the Village was changed the name of the paper was also changed to the Interlaken Review.
